Researchers turn grape juice to wine

They named their new strain "Leuconostoc oenos—PSU-1."

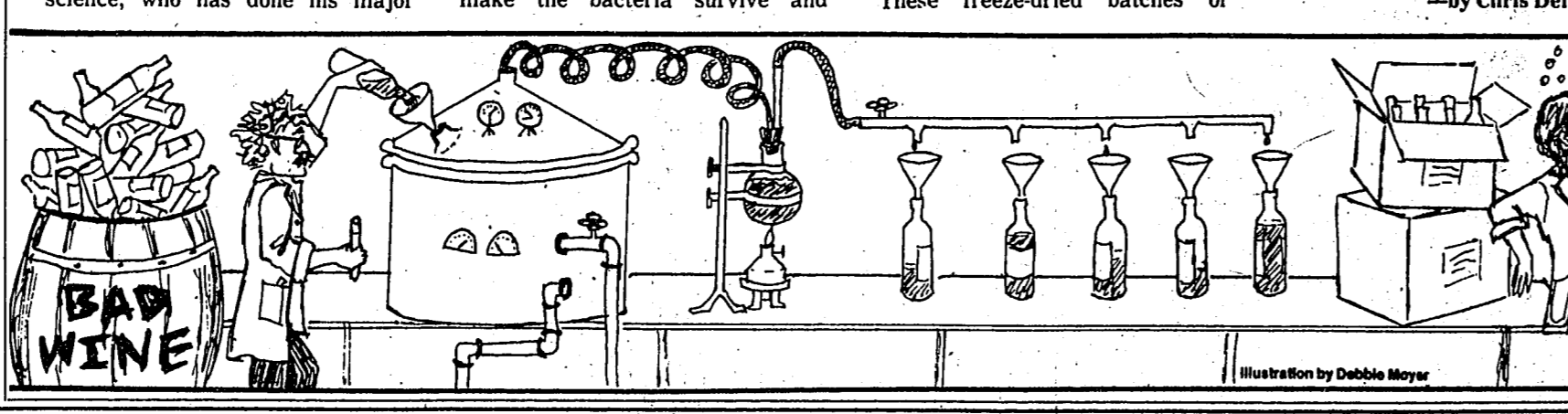

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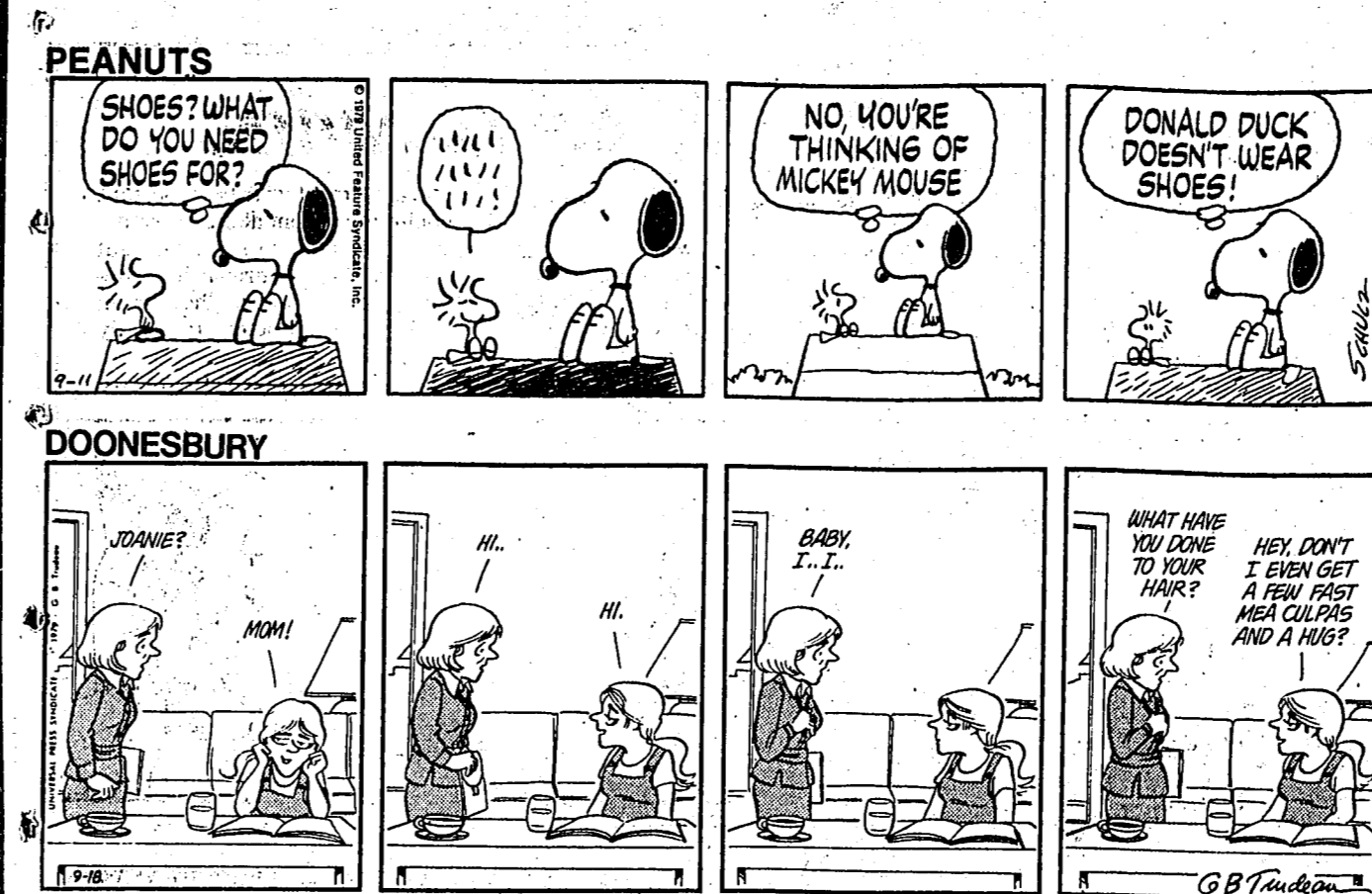
