

# USG filing suit against Datematch company over fee

The Undergraduate Student Government is filing a suit against the company that runs Datematch because of a contract dispute, USG's chairman of the board of directors said.

Gordy Beitenmiller said Interpersonal Research Inc. is being sued for \$673.90 because of a dispute about an ambiguous fee schedule.

"It's been difficult to work with Interpersonal Research," he said. "You can look at the fee schedule and read it his way or read it our way."

Craig Miller, assistant vice president for student affairs, said he thought USG should press the suit.

"It was in their financial means to do it, it was in their financial means to do it," he said.

Randy Foster, a representative for Interpersonal Research Inc., refused to comment on the pending suit.

Beitenmiller said a fee schedule shows the processing fees for different quantities and types of computer data forms.

The suit has been filed with District Magistrate Court in York County pending a response by Foster. Foster has until April 24 to say whether he will defend the suit or not.

USG will win the case by default if Foster chooses not to press the suit, Beitenmiller said.

If the courts decide the contract fee schedule is ambiguous, the case will be decided in favor of USG, Beitenmiller said.

Even if USG wins the suit it might not get the money because Interpersonal Research could appeal to a higher court or not voluntarily pay USG, he said.

If Interpersonal Research does not voluntarily pay USG, a lengthy court process would have to be carried out," Beitenmiller said.

Beitenmiller said he "had no idea" when the case would go to court but he expected a hearing date to be set before the end of the term.

Beitenmiller said when USG paid Interpersonal Research it felt the contract was incorrect.

However, USG agreed to pay Interpersonal Research anyway because it wanted students to get their computer data forms on time and avoid bad publicity for USG, he said.

"We decided to pay the full amount because we didn't think USG needed the publicity of what would appear to be mismanagement," Beitenmiller said.

Datematch did not show a profit this year, Beitenmiller said. It was \$19.91 in the red, Beitenmiller said.

"It (the suit) makes a big difference in the profit of the project," he said.

"We spent money based on costs that we thought were going to be low—you can see how a mistake would hurt us."

Attorney fees and court costs for USG will be \$185, which would leave a \$488.92 profit margin for USG if it won the case, he said.

"If we win, the defendant pays all costs except for the attorney's fee," Beitenmiller said.

USG's suit represents a deviation from that organization's past policies, he said.

For the past two years, USG has agreed with Interpersonal Research's interpretation of the fee schedule; however, this year Beitenmiller said he realized USG was being ripped off and decided to do something about it.

"Student organizations traditionally, and USG specifically, have too often not stood up when they've thought they'd been wrong," he said.

"We feel we've been wrong and we'll work to try and right it," he said.

This year's Datematch had 1,827 student participants. In past years, between 3,000 and 4,000 students participated.

In a recent article in The Daily Collegian, Beitenmiller said the decline was because Datematch was held Winter Term instead of Fall Term as in previous years.

# Golf courses are ready for spring putters.

You may never wish the Masters, but that's no excuse not to take advantage of the University golf courses.

Penn State has two 18-hole courses and a driving range. The White course is on the west side of North Atherton Street and the Blue course and driving range are located two miles west of North Atherton, off College Avenue.

The courses are open to the public, students and faculty members. Term passes are available for \$40, club retail is \$3 for the day and students can play 18 holes for \$4. Half-hour private lessons can be acquired for \$8 and group lessons are \$4 an hour.

Students can also learn the fine points of the game through a physical education class.

Course manager Earl Boal said the quality of the courses this spring "came out a lot better than had been expected. Usually, snow covered courses are ideal because the snow keeps the soil protected from the cold wind, which can burn the grass."

"Although there wasn't much snow this winter, the courses came around. In fact, it's ideal for April," he said.

Eric Reagle (3rd-year civil engineering) said he likes the White course, but that the Blue course, because of its longer holes and narrower fairways, is more challenging.

But golfers are not the only ones who take advantage of the rolling fairways and grassy knolls. Joggers also make their presence known.

"It's great," said Don Hayduk (2nd-year chemical engineering), who jogs on the four-mile trail on the perimeter of the courses three or four times a week. "Lots of people use this place," he said.

Although the jogging trail parallels many of the fairways and winds around some of the greens, Hayduk said he has never been hit by a stray ball, which usually results from a slice or a hook.

Mark Seifelt (3rd-year English writing option), said the golf facilities were better than he had expected. "I've played at, on nice days, it gets backed-up a little."
