# Calendar council to meet

## Registration and renumbering to be discussed

The Calendar Conversion Council will discuss a proposal to renumber courses and a possible trial student registration for Fall Semester 1981 when it convenes for its first meeting of the 1981-82 academic year at this afternoon.

Today's meeting will be the 10th meeting of the 17-member council, which was formed last spring to coordinate and expedite calendar conversion activities.

First on today's agenda is a proposal to change the University's course numbering system. A revised course numbering system could help in determining when a student would take a given course, council member James R. Dungan said.

He said, however, that such a plan might not accommodate some of the University's courses which are taken by students of all academic standings.

"Most universities have a simple system for numbering courses in which the 100 level is for freshmen, the 200 level is for sophomores, and so on," said Dungan. "However, Penn State has courses like English 10. I think a total renumbering may be desirable but whether it is feasible is a different question."

The council will also discuss the possibility of having students trial register for the 1981 Fall Semester during this spring's registration.

"A trial registration one year in advance of the semester change) would tell us how well course offerings would meet student demand," he said. "We are used to offering courses three times a year and we need to get an idea of whether we will be offering enough sections of, say English 10, to meet the demand twice a year."

To ensure that individual academic departments will not suffer an increased workload while revising courses and

programs, the council will also discuss ways to improve communication between itself, the University Faculty Senate and individual departments.

Also at the meeting, the chairmen of the Summer Session Committee and the Faculty Contracts Committee will deliver information reports to the council.

The Calendar Conversion Council will continue its responsibility until the end of the 1981-82 academic year.

Dungan said student interest in the calendar change could increase this year because both the freshmen and sophomores will be affected by it.

"This year approximately one-half of the students at the University will be involved in the calendar conversion and in the following year, three-fourths of the students will be affected," he said.

"Therefore, I think that the interest in the calendar conversion will be stronger this year than last year."

# Flights to be held to 75 percent

WASHINGTON (AP) — Commercial flights likely will be held to about 75 percent their normal pace through most of 1982 as the government rebuilds the air traffic control system with new employees, Federal Aviation Administrator J. Lynn Helms said Tuesday.

Helms and Transportation Secretary Drew Lewis assured congressmen that the current system is working safely and effectively without the 11,500 controllers fired after they struck on Aug. 5.

Helms noted that the FAA already has told air carriers to limit their flights to about 75 percent of the pre-strike level through next April, but he said "current traffic levels will likely be maintained throughout most of next year."

"In the second year of rebuilding, though, we expect to permit traffic levels to increase at a steady pace to a point at which pre-strike traffic levels can be reached on a daily basis," the FAA chief continued.

It will be well into the third year until traffic levels at peak hours will reach their former levels, and the busy New York and Chicago areas will be the last to achieve their full capacity, he added.

The FAA has kept the control system operating with about 8,300 non-union controllers, supervisors and military personnel while stepping up the hiring of new permanent employees.

During about 2 1/2 hours of testimony, Helms and Lewis insisted repeatedly that no shortcuts are being taken that would compromise the safety of the flying public.

But two members of the House Government Operations subcommittee on transportation remained unconvinced.

His voice rising, Rep. Tom Lantos, D-Calif., accused Lewis of a "very cavalier attitude" and smugness in the face of concerns about safety.

"I'm not sitting here with a self-satisfied or cavalier attitude," Lewis retorted. "I'm here with a problem I'm trying to solve."

Rep. Tom Weiss, D-N.Y., drew applause from supporters of the striking Professional Air Traffic Controllers Organization in the audience when he said the government testimony made him even more shaky about flying.

Helms said none of the controllers on duty now is working more than a scheduled 48-hour week, although bad weather has forced some to put in overtime, and 30 percent are down to the normal 40-hour schedule.

The FAA chief said his major concern was to prevent fatigue by those personnel after the initial "emotional high" of keeping the system operating went off in the coming months.

But he said that in addition to shortening the work week, putting newly trained controllers and civilian personnel will permit the agency to begin scheduling vacations that had to be put off this summer.

PATCO officials were not invited to testify at the hearing, which continues Wednesday, because the subcommittee chairman, Rep. John L. Burton, D-Calif., said he wanted to confine the inquiry to the control system itself and not the labor-management dispute.

But Lewis took the opportunity in his formal statement to reiterate the Reagan administration's stand that the mass firings were necessary.
