Cotton tickets not choice pick

PITTSBURGH — The University of Pittsburgh, fearful of being left with thousands of unsold tickets to the Cotton Bowl, has twice mailed letters to season ticket holders asking them to buy tickets for the Jan. 1 game against Southern Methodist

But travel agents have handled little business with Pitt fans traveling to Dallas, although they are having no trouble selling packages for Penn State's game against Georgia in the Sugar Bowl in New Orleans. "And that's sad, because this is a Pitt town - it's not a

Penn State town," said Wayne C. Lacock, president of Wavne Travel in Pittsburgh. Lacock is sold out of tickets on one charter to the Sugar Bowl and is arranging another tour through Chicago, But even though he holds over 100 tickets on the 50-yard line

for the Pitt-SMU game, he said Tuesday he will have trouble selling even a third of them. "It's disastrous." he said. "It's sad. As soon as Penn State beat Pitt (on Nov. 26), all of the interest in Pitt going

to a bowl game died out. But we've been swamped for weeks with people wanting to go to the Sugar Bowl.'

Pitt's two closest football rivals. West Virginia and Penn State, are both going to bowls, since West Virginia is playing in the Gator Bowl. West Virginia sold out of its 18,000-ticket allotment in one day and Penn State's ticket office has sold thousands of tickets, but Pitt ticket officials are reluctant to say how many tickets they've sold. "I'm not at liberty to give out that information," ticket manager Mel Cratsley said Tuesday. "Well, I am at

liberty, but I don't want to say anything." He then directed queries to John Blanton, the school's athletic business manager and assistant athletic director. Blanton said he "hasn't got a fix" on how many tickets the Panthers have sold. However, he would not classify the ticket sales as "poor," although he wouldn't give out any numbers.

Pitt officials have returned one batch of tickets to Dallas. The Panthers reportedly were offered 12,000, and are now trying to dispose of 9,000 tickets. Lacock, a Panther season ticket holder, said the second

letter he received from Pitt inferred that season ticket holders should buy a ticket, even if they weren't planning on going to Dallas.

"You could read between the lines," he said.






