

# USFL completes draft of 600

NEW YORK (AP) — The player draft of the upstart USFL concluded yesterday with 600 players divided among the new league's 12 teams and battle lines drawn with the NFL.

The United States Football League tabbed just about all the stars the National Football League will be going after in its draft next April. By then, the USFL will have two months into its inaugural season.

"We have the opportunity, by drafting now, to get the jump on

them," USFL Commissioner Chet Simmons said of the older, wealthier league.

There were 24 rounds of drafting plus territorial negotiations lists. Of the 600 players, 323 are on the offense, 263 on defense and 14 on special teams.

"Now we look forward to getting out there and getting some signatures on some contracts," Simmons said at the conclusion of the two-day draft, the final six rounds held yesterday.

As for a bidding war between the leagues, Simmons said, "right now, they've got a sales point. They can tell a player, 'Why not wait a while,

see where we'll draft you?' They may take some players out of the marketplace for us."

The NFL has the right to move its draft from the end of April to the beginning of February, starting next year.

"Next year, if they draft about the same time we do, the decisions will come a lot quicker," Simmons said.

Simmons said that if players bypass the start of the USFL season and see where they go in the NFL draft, it doesn't mean they can't make themselves available in April to the USFL teams that drafted them.

# Steelers' Noll looks to Super Bowl

PITTSBURGH (AP) — If the Pittsburgh Steelers continue the style and quality of their past two performances, Coach Chuck Noll says they have a good shot at recapturing the Super Bowl glory.

"If we play like we played in the last two weeks, we can go as far as we want to go," Noll said Tuesday. "I think we have as good an opportunity as anyone else."

Noll said the Steelers' sparkling play in their 37-14 win over New England on Dec. 26 and their 57-21 victory over Cleveland on Sunday were good enough to beat anyone through the coming playoffs.

In those two games, the 6-3 Steelers, led by veteran back Franco Harris, rushed for an average of 237 yards and quarterback Terry Bradshaw passed for an average of 271 yards. The Steelers' defense held opponents to an average of just 50 yards on the ground.

But making the playoffs alone is not much to brag about, according to Noll.

"If making the playoffs this year is good enough, then forget it," Noll said. "It's not quite what you want to strive for."

The Steelers play host to the 6-3 San Diego Chargers in a first-round AFC playoff game on Sunday. Noll says the game may come down to Pittsburgh's ability to stop Chargers' quarterback Dan Fouts.

"Their whole philosophy is that they want to throw the football, and if you're thinking pass, they'll run right past you," Noll said. "They want to do the thing you think they're not going to do."

Both Noll and San Diego Coach Don Coryell insisted Tuesday that the weekend's weather won't be a factor for the warm-weather Chargers. The Chargers are hurt by last January's "Ice Bowl" in Cincinnati, where San Diego lost a chance at the Super Bowl and a 59-degree below wind chill factor gave Fouts frostbite on his fingers.

"Obviously, we'd like to have something reasonable... not where people can get hurt," Coryell said in a telephone interview. "But we both have to play in the same weather."
