Duran goes for WBA championship against Moore

NEW YORK (AP) — Roberto Duran could step back on the glory road or begin life looking back at his mostly illustrious past when he challenges Davey Moore for the World Boxing Association junior middleweight championship tonight at Madison Square Garden.

betting line on the scheduled 15-round fight, but one said that if he handled any action, he would make Duran a 2-1 favorite.

"I don't believe two or three years ago a guy with 12 fights would have anything to go with me," said Duran, who will be 32 the day of the fight, which is scheduled to start between 10:30 p.m. and 10:45 p.m. EDT. It will be shown on closed-circuit television and as pay-per-view TV in certain areas, as well as on a delayed basis by CBS Sunday.

Duran said he had stomach cramps, and he has never changed his story.

"I don't think I will lose, but in case I would lose, I would retire."

10-round decisions over Nino Gonzalez and Luigi Minichillo in 1981. Then Jan. 20, 1982, he was easily outpointed over 15 rounds in a title bid against Wilfredo Benitez, the WBC super welterweight (junior middleweight) champion.

After that fight, Carlos Eleta, Duran's longtime manager, split with the fighter, saying he should retire. So Luis Henriquez, a longtime Duran agent, became his manager for a 10-round fight against Kirkland Laing of Britain, which was promoted by Don King. Laing won, and Henriquez and King left Duran, saying he should retire.

For Arum, he won a dull 10-round decision over Jimmy Batten in the walkout fight on the Aaron Pryor-Alexis Arguello WBA junior welterweight title card in Miami, Fla., last Nov. 12 — and he looked like an old fighter doing it.

Davey Moore was a spectator. "... I walked out after the third round," he said. But Duran looked good in stopping Pipino Cuevas, the former WBA welterweight champion, in the fourth round last Jan. 29, although many boxing observers considered Cuevas washed up as a fighter.

The victory gave Duran a 75-4-0 record, with 56 knockouts.
