

## Stansbury passes up Olympic tryout offer

PHILADELPHIA (AP) — Four Pennsylvania college basketball players are among 74 invited to the 1984 U.S. Olympic basketball trials later this month but one, Temple's Terence Stansbury, says he's passing up the chance so he won't miss school.

"My goal is to get my degree (in distributive education) from Temple by the summer," the 6-foot-5 guard said Tuesday. "If I had gone to the tryouts, that would have been delayed."

The Olympic trials are scheduled April 17-22 at Indiana University in Bloomington.

Stansbury, Temple's all-time leading scorer, averaged 18.6 points a game this season and is expected to be a first-round draft choice in the coming NBA draft.

Other Pennsylvania players invited to the Olympic trials are St. Joseph's guard-forward Maurice Martin, Villanova forward Ed Pinckney and La Salle guard Steve Black.

Martin, a 6-6 sophomore, averaged 15.6 points a game.

## Colts' abrupt move met with legal action

BALTIMORE (AP) — In addition to legal action started by city officials, the Colts' NFL franchise now faces two lawsuits by Maryland residents angry about the team's move from Baltimore to Indianapolis.

In Baltimore County Circuit Court, a \$30 million class action was filed Monday by a couple on behalf of all Colts fans, charging that the club's sudden departure in the middle of the night last week has caused "severe emotional distress."

And in U.S. Bankruptcy Court, an engineer filed suit Tuesday against the Colts for \$8,000 in back pay that he claims is due for game films he took in 1983.

The class action was initiated by J. Robert and Mildred C. Sachse of Towson, Md., who charged that Colts owner Robert Irsay had nurtured fans' "emotional bond" with the team by repeatedly promising to stay in Baltimore, only to suddenly move the team last week.

The late-night move was designed "to humiliate

and degrade the plaintiffs and these similarly situated," the suit contends. It says the move has caused the Sachses to suffer "severe depression, severe physical and emotional disability, severe disturbance of mental and emotional tranquility and mental distress of a very serious kind."

But, asked whether she thought she would win the suit, Mrs. Sachse said: "Not really. But what else could we do to express our feelings? We've been fans from the beginning."

The Bankruptcy Court suit by engineer Robert McMahon Sr. was the first action to be filed by a local concern in the federal court system.

McMahon said he has taken films of the Colts games for the team's benefit for several years, but he received no payment for his 1983 work.

Steven Fruin, a partner of McMahon's attorney, Arnold Weiner, said the Colts had 20 days to respond to the suit. Fruin said he expects other creditors will soon join in legal action against the Colts.

At Irsay's office in Chicago, a secretary said neither the Colts owner nor his attorney, Michael Chernoff, would be available to make any comment on legal actions against the team.

Meanwhile, at the Statehouse in Annapolis, a state senator started a fund-raising drive for individual contributors to support legal efforts to bring the Colts back to Baltimore.

Sen. Thomas Brownwell, D-Baltimore County, said he had established a telephone number for Colts fans to pledge contributions, and he said he hoped to hold a fund-raiser at the Baltimore Convention Center in May.

City officials, in their suit against the Colts, have received a temporary order by a Circuit Court judge requiring the Colts to stay in Baltimore for 10 days. The Colts responded to that by asking the U.S. District Court to take jurisdiction in the matter because it crosses state lines.

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
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
