The committee will next consider the shot clock issue at a meeting after next year's Final Four tournament in money." Lexington, Ky. Ed Steitz, the committee's secretary-rules editor, predicted it would be adopted then.

Steitz, athletic director at Springfield (Mass.) College, was the only member of the committee to appear at a press conference after the closed-door meeting. "The vote was very, very close," he said.

Steitz said the committee decided not to go with the shot clock at this time, "as a result of uncertainty in the minds of some of the members of the committee whether or not to go with a clock for the entire game."

Some of the committee members wanted the shot clock used during the entire game while others favored shutting "So it was an inability of the committee members to

have a meeting of the minds on whether to keep the clock on for the entire game or turn it off for, say, the last four, two or one minutes," he said. In order for the rules committee to adopt a uniform,

nationwide shot clock, it would have required a two-thirds vote of the 13-member committee. Steitz refused to disclose the vote, explaining, "

reveal our precise votes." He said his earlier prediction that the 45-second shot clock would be adopted for the 1984-85 season was "just




