Community Theatre opens a new comedy at the Boal Barn

The State College Community Theatre will open its fourth production of the summer tomorrow night at the Boal Barn Playhouse.

"The Curious Savage," by John Patrick, is the story of Mrs. Savage, a woman left with \$11 million due to her husband's death. She decides to use it to help other people make their dreams come true, but her step-children from her late husband's first marriage view her intentions as crazy and commit her to a sanitarium.

Although there is obviously nothing mentally or physically wrong with Mrs. Savage, she moves into the sanitarium, called the Cloisters, which is a lovely old house with various social misfits. During her stay, she meets the other guests who, like herself, have their own stories to tell.

Her children, still hungry to collect the \$11 million they feel is theirs, are sent on a wild goose chase to the White House in Washington to recover the money. Mrs. Savage tells them that she has buried the money, in bonds of \$500,000, in the president's greenhouse.

Back at the Cloisters, however, the witty Mrs. Savage has grown to like her new home because her friends there like her, not her money. And even after her doctor tells her that she is free to leave, Mrs. Savage says she wants to spend the rest of her life there.

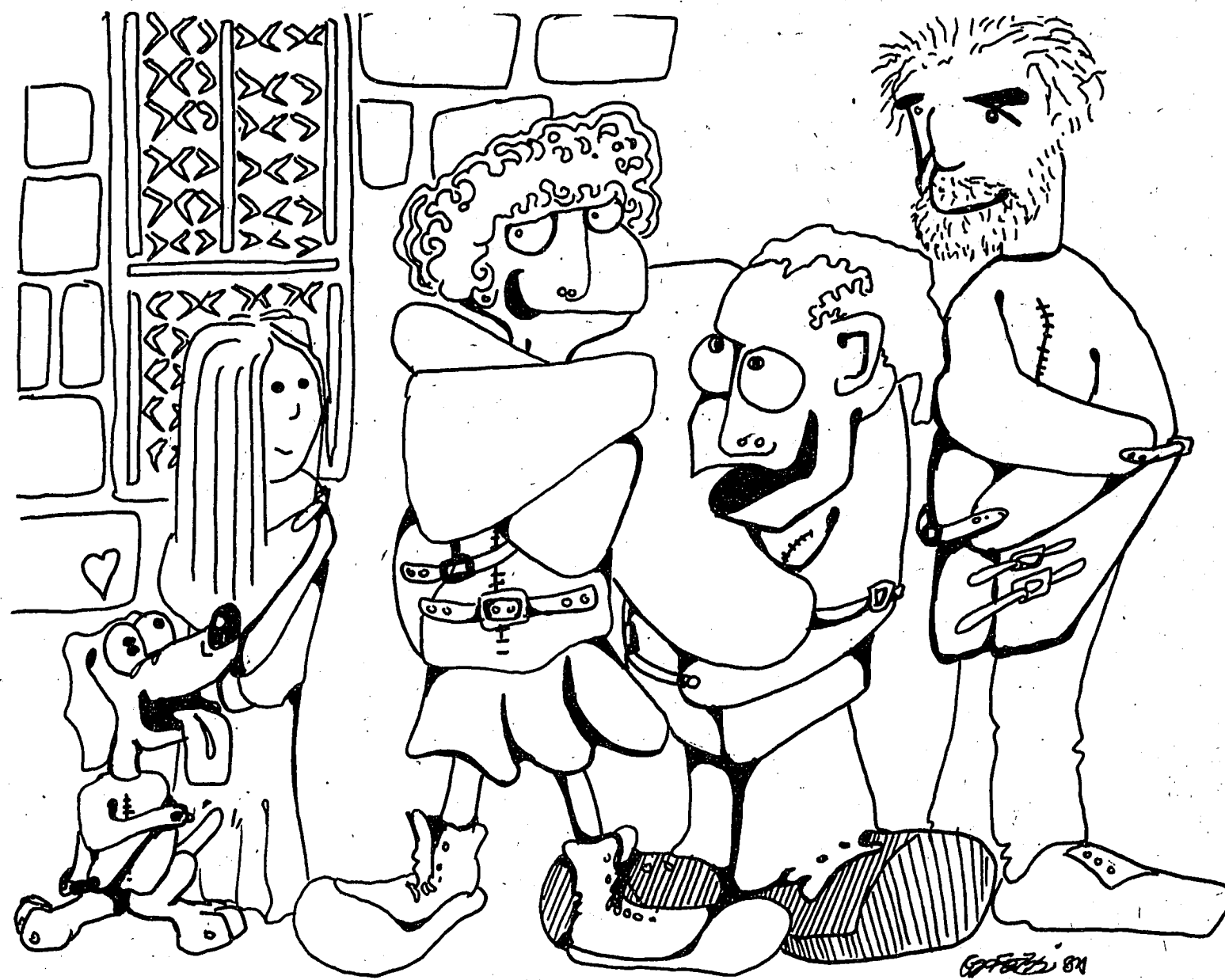
Theater board member Bea Berlin describes the play as "a feel-good show." "The Curious Savage" is a comedy," Berlin insists, "and a very funny one at that. It's definitely a family show."

The cast of almost a dozen includes Marjorie Hill as Mrs. Savage, Richard Gides and David Harry as "Tus and Samuel, her step-sons, and Pat Hazleton as Lily Belle, Savage's step-daughter.

The guests at the Cloisters are Florence (Becky Boyer), Hannibal (Gary Gates), Fairy May (Cyndi Yost), Jeffrey (Thomas Jenkins), and Mrs. Paddy (Binkie Gasholm).

The Cloisters' Staff includes Susanna Ritti as Miss Willy and Rob Weaver as Dr. Emmett.

"The Curious Savage" runs Aug. 1 through 4 and 7 through 11 at the Boal Barn Playhouse. Tickets are \$4 for adults, \$3 for those over 65 or under 18. Curtain time is 8:30 p.m.
