Lady spikers hold tryouts tonight

Tryouts for the women's volleyball team will be held at 6:30 p.m. tonight in Rec Hall's South Gym. Head Coach Russ Rose said he plans to keep between 10 and 22 players on this year's team. Thirteen spots are already claimed with five returning players and eight recruits. Seniors Lori Barberich and Marcia Leap will front the Lady Lions in their attempt to repeat as Atlantic 10 Conference champs and return to the National Collegiate Athletic Association tournament for the fourth straight time. Marcia Leap's sister, Lisa, leads the list of freshman hopefuls for Penn State. Leap and the other seven recruits have added depth to the Lady Lion squad, according to tri-captain Patty Skadeland. Penn State opens its schedule on Sept. 14 by making an appearance in the Cardinal Invitational in Louisville, Kentucky. Thompson sues Studio 54 disco

NEW YORK (AP) — David Thompson of the Seattle SuperSonics filed a \$50 million lawsuit yesterday against the owners of the Studio 54 discotheque, charging its employees may have ended his career by assaulting him. The 6-foot-4-inch guard charged that as a result of a beating he suffered inside the Manhattan club last March 10, his "career as a professional basketball player has been placed in severe jeopardy and may not be continued." He said the beating caused him to miss most of the 1983-84 NBA season. No comment could be obtained from Cobham Enterprises, Inc., owner of the club, in calls to Studio 54 or its publicity agent. The suit at U.S. District Court in Manhattan asserts that Thompson was walking up a flight of stairs at 5 a.m. when he was attacked by an NBA employee, identified in the suit as defendant Martin Santiago of Staten Island. Thompson, who lives in Englewood, Colo., fell down the stairs, where other employees grabbed him, dragged him, and threw him onto the street, the suit charges. Thompson said he suffered a permanent knee injury, as well as injuries to his head and teeth. Thompson, 30, was an All-American player at North Carolina State, leading the team to the National Collegiate Athletic Association title in 1974. He was named an NBA all-star four times and once scored 73 points in a game. Last season, he played 19 of the team's 82 games, averaging 12.6 points per game.
