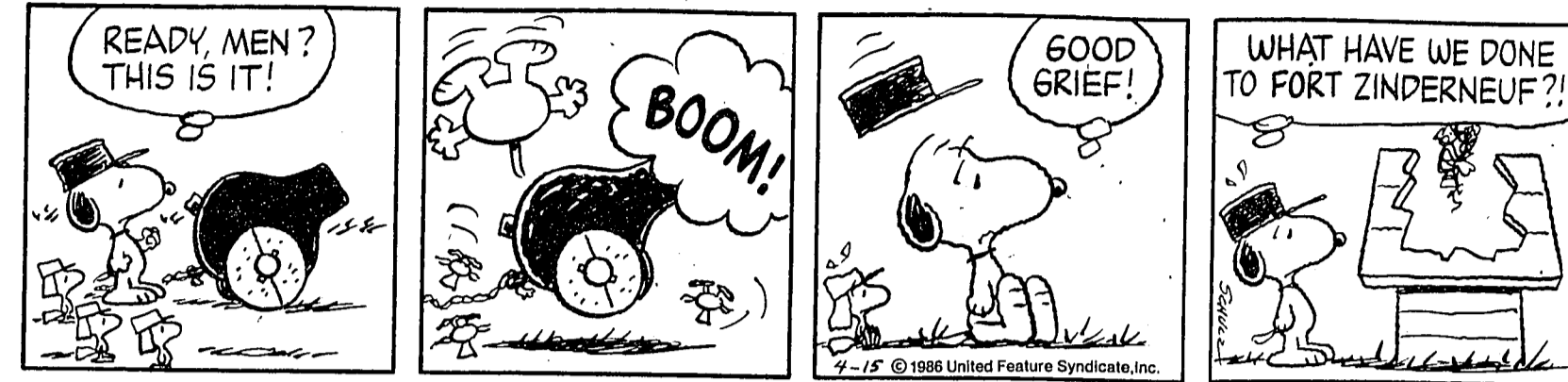

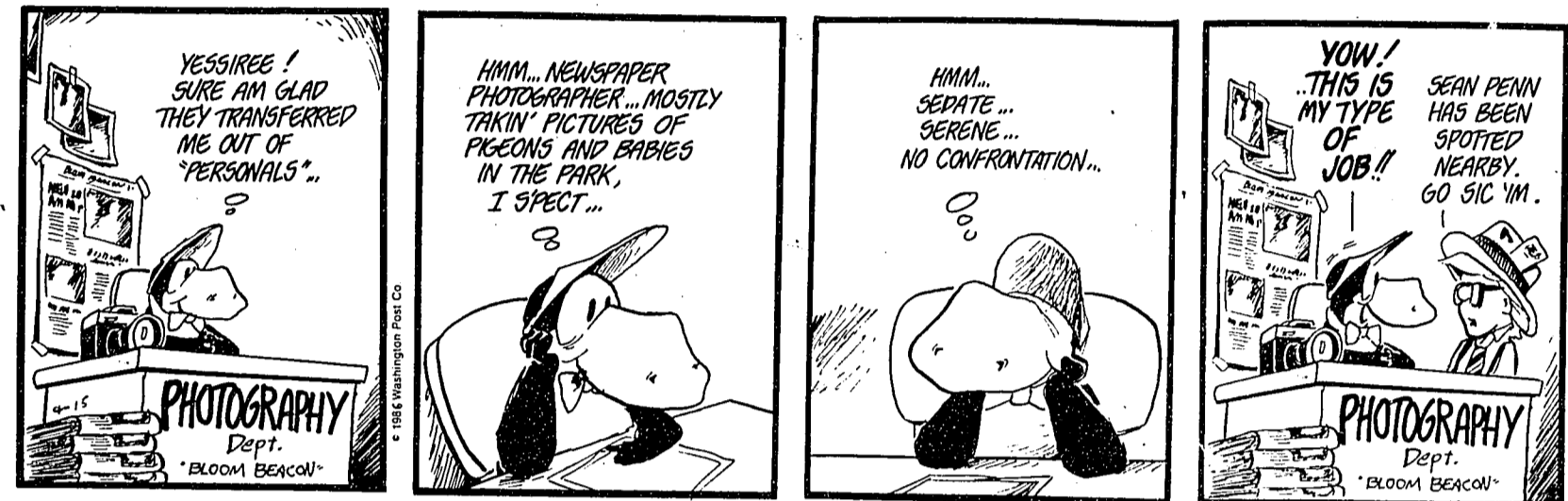

What's The Difference?

Notice the Q on the left. The outline is rough, density is uneven and quality—well, it just isn't there. This Q was printed by a daisy-wheel printer and enlarged to show detail.

Now, look at the Q on the right. The outline is perfect. The density of the letter is equal all-around and the letter is crisp, clean and clear. This Q was set by a typesetter and enlarged to show detail.

Typesetters are designed to produce perfect letters. Everything is considered—letter width, vertical height, spacing between letters—both horizontally and vertically—and density of the letter.

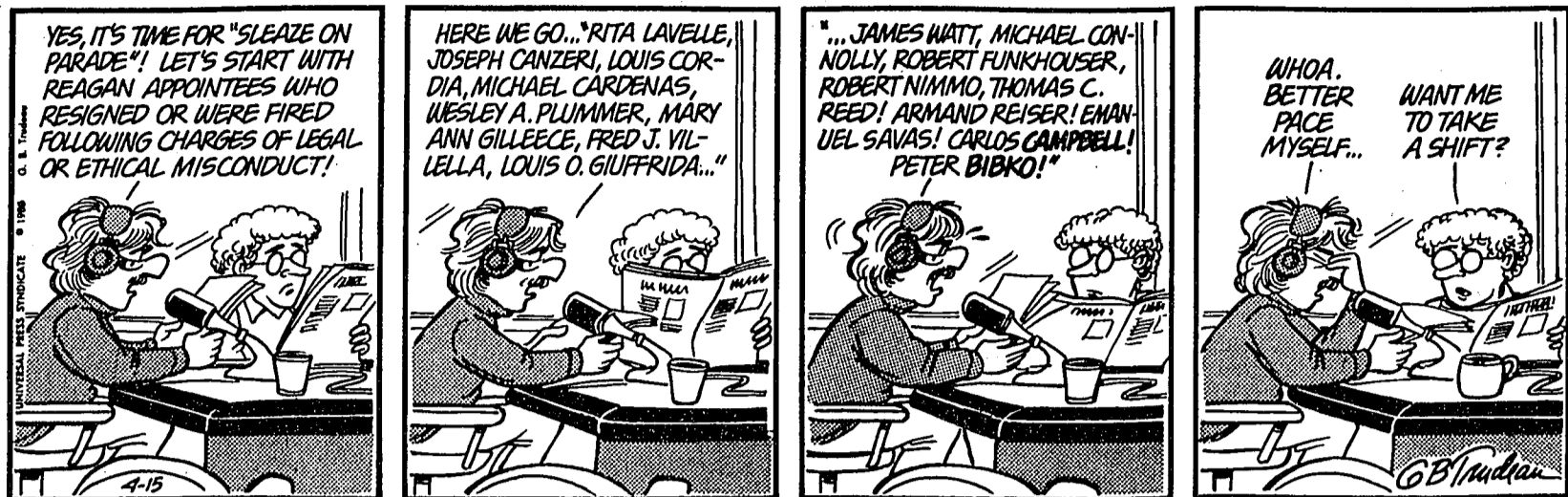
