





ATTENTION STUDENTS FALL SEMESTER DROP / ADD PROCEDURES

DURING THE FIRST FOUR DAYS of classes (August 27, 28, 29, and Sept. 2), students have TWO OPTIONS for making drop/add adjustments: AT THE DEPARTMENT TERMINALS any* course may be added* or dropped between the hours of 8:00 a.m. and 12:00 noon.

- meet with your adviser,
- complete a registration/schedule adjustment form, — take the form to your home department for ALL* drop/add adjustments.

BY TELEPHONE any* course may be added* or dropped between the hours of 3:00 p.m. and 10:00 p.m.

- meet with your adviser
- complete a registration/schedule adjustment form,
- call 863-9000 and provide the operator with the six-digit schedule number of ALL* courses to be added or dropped,

- pick up a revised copy of your schedule at any department office the next day.

Starting September 3, any* full semester course may be added* (until Sept. 5) or dropped (until Sept. 16) at any department office during normal business hours.

- Any special condition such as time conflict, duplicate course request, etc. must be cleared at the academic department offering the course. — The following courses are under special registration control and may only be added at the academic department offering the course.




