The IBF withdrew championship recognition from Spinks for refusing to agree to a mandatory defense against Tony Tucker, who now holds that title. Mike Tyson is recognized as champion by the WBC and the World Boxing Association.

When the fight was announced formally in April, Spinks said, "It's the one the public wants."

It appears Convention Hall will be filled to capacity, but closed-circuit television ticket sales throughout the country generally have been poor, and the telecast has been canceled at several locations. One cancellation Wednesday was at the 20,000-seat Joe Louis Arena in Detroit after 16 tickets had been sold.

Spinks is guaranteed \$4 million, while Cooney is guaranteed \$2.5 million. Donald Trump, who operates two Atlantic City hotel-casinos, paid \$3.5 million for the live gate.

The fight is scheduled to begin at 10:40 p.m. EDT.

Spinks concedes Cooney's size could present a problem.

"Fighting a guy that tall, you have trouble hitting them the way you want to," Spinks said. He hopes to make Cooney lunge, thereby presenting a better target.

"The more Spinks reaches for the face, the more he's going to get hit in the body," said Victor Valie, who trains Cooney.

Cooney's money punch is a left hook to the head and body. But in throwing it, a fighter is open for a right hand from his opponent.

A hook is a daring punch, especially a long hook," Futch said.

"Before Gerry was throwing the left hook too long," Valie said. "Now he's tucking in his elbows."

But, Spinks said, "I can't be acting like I'm scared of Gerry Cooney. I'm

not. I'm looking for an opportunity to hit him with my Sunday punch (a right)."

"I know I can knock him out. All you need are three or four good shots, and they'll go."

Spinks has scored 20 knockouts, but 19 were against light heavyweights, whose weight limit is 175 pounds.

Ray Knight, Cal Ripken Jr. and Jim Dwyer hit home runs yesterday as the Orioles beat Toronto 8-5, snapping the Blue Jays' club-record 11-game winning streak.

The Orioles, who set a major-league record for home runs in May, have hit 97 homers this season, tops in the majors.

Baltimore's drought was the fourth-longest in team history. Toronto ended a 6-1 road trip, the best in club history, in which it outscored Baltimore and New York 61-24.

"We had to sweat it out at the end, and that wasn't a good sign," Dwyer said after Toronto rallied from a 5-1 deficit. "But it was good to win a game."

With the score tied 1-1, Alan Trammell drew a two-out walk from Bruce Hurst, 7-5. Larry Herndon singled Trammell to second and Heath, who hit a sacrifice fly in the seventh, lined a single for the winning run. Herndon, Morris, 9-2, allowed six hits and struck out 10. His winning streak is the longest in the American League since 1924.

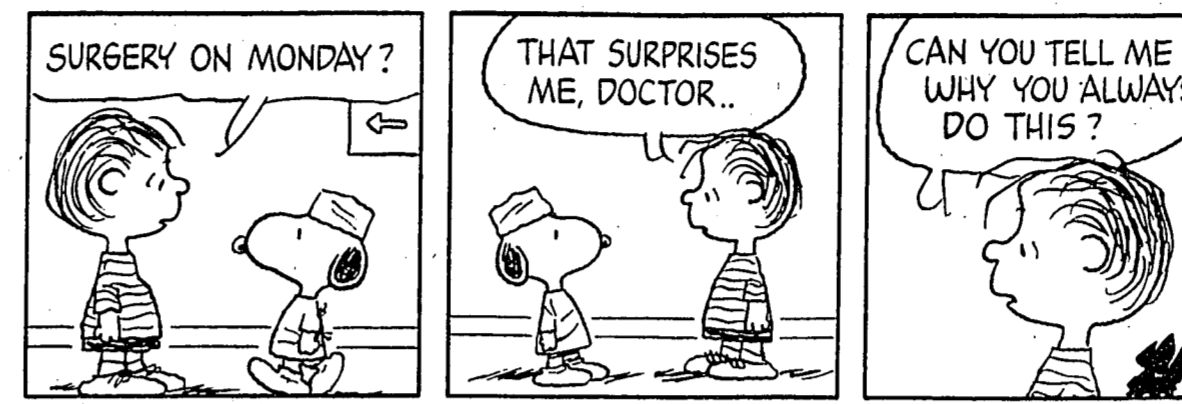

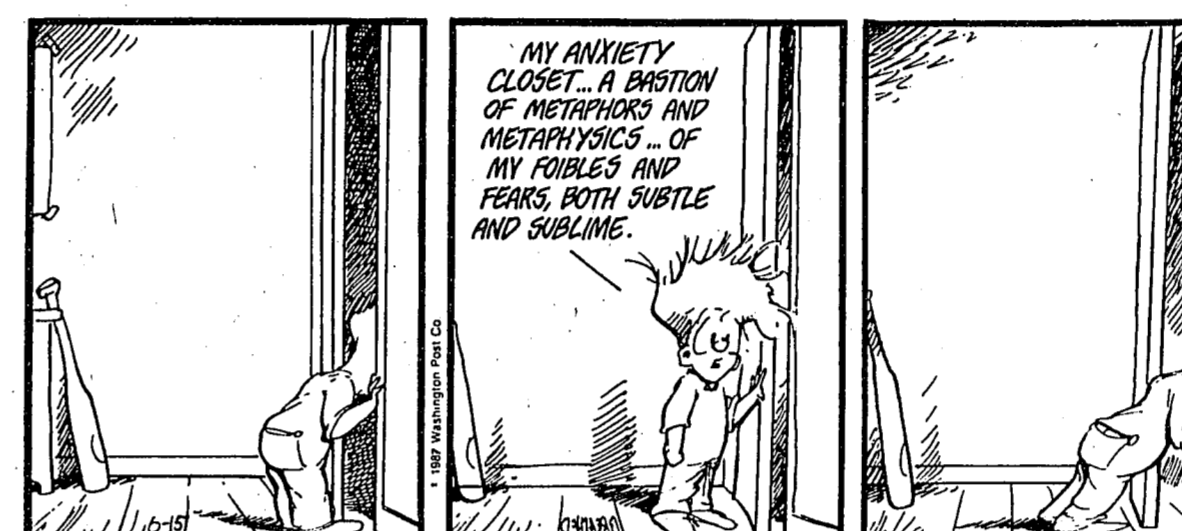

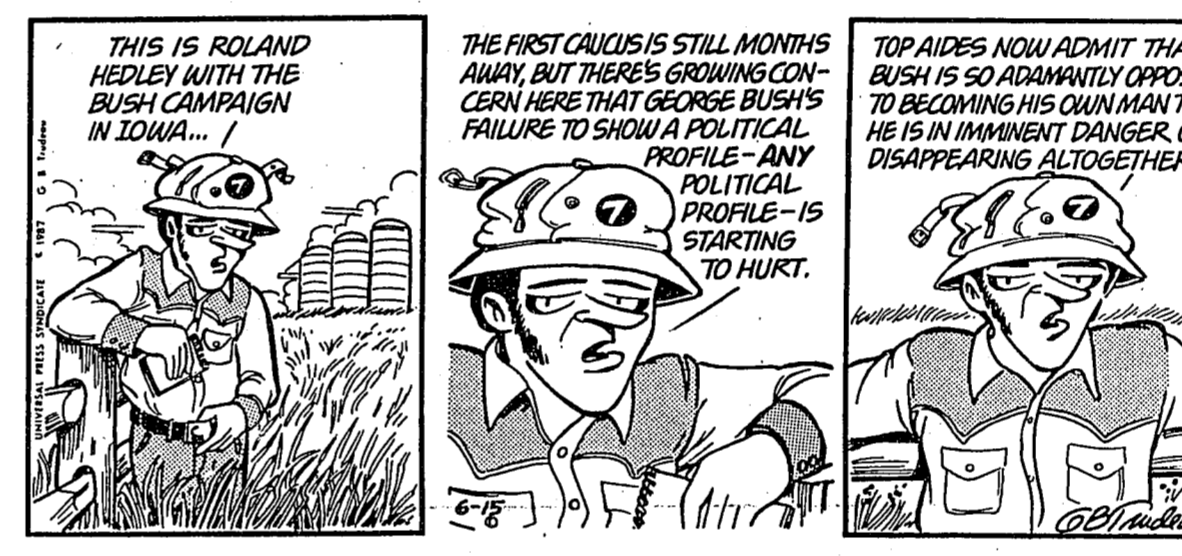
