Escort service use going up this fall

More students are using the Student Escort Service this year to ensure safer walks home at night, the coordinator of the service said. Eric Barson said about 90 students call the service each month — an increase from last year's 50 calls.

"The majority of the students who call are women, but occasionally a male student will call for an escort," said Joe Hatzell, a counselor and escort.

About 150 men volunteer their time, seven days a week, to accompany people home during the late hours of the night.

Calls are accepted from 5 p.m. to midnight but the service supplies escorts after midnight on request.

Hatzell said the service receives about three to five calls a night.

The Student Counselors program, a division of The Center for Assistance and Information, operates the escort service.

Volunteers are interviewed by the counselors and screened through the Office of Conduct Standards before becoming an escort, Barson said.

Betty Moore, assistant director of the Center for Assistance and Information, and several students developed the service about six years ago after two rapes occurred on campus.

"Generally, we prefer for students to call ahead of time for an escort," he said.

But the service also supplies escorts to immediate calls, which normally come from Pattee, class-

room buildings and the HUB, Barson said.

Lori Emerich (junior-secondary education and math), used the service one night last spring when she wanted to walk to Nittany Apartments, 600 E. Pollock Rd., from Centre Halls. She called at about 10 p.m. and explained she needed an escort for later that evening, she said.

The service called her back and gave her the escort's name, and student number, and physical description so when her escort appeared, she could verify his ID number.

Emerich said her escort was nice and "was even willing to walk back out for me when I wanted to come home."

She said the service is valuable, especially when the buses have stopped operating for the night.

"I would have never gone out to the apartments at all that night," Emerich said. "I don't think people use it enough."

The service is funded by Inter Fraternity Council, The Panhellenic Council and Association Residence Hall Students, Barson said.
