Ocasio sustained a shoulder injury. He was taken to Centre Community Hospital where he was treated and released.

Mathew Winkoop is in serious condition in Centre Community Hospital with a fractured leg and facial injuries, a hospital supervisor said.

Police reported that Winkoop was driving with his brother Harold Winkoop when he lost control of the car and hit two signs and a tree. Harold Winkoop was only slightly injured in the accident. No damage estimate was given.
