Specter wants review of Thornburgh aide

HARRISBURG — U.S. Sen. Arlen Specter has asked that a special prosecutor investigate cocaine use allegations against a former top aide to U.S. Attorney General Richard Thornburgh, the senator's spokesman said Monday.

Specter, R-Pa., asked for an independent counsel to look into whether former U.S. Justice Department lawyer Henry Barr used cocaine. The senator acted after former state Auditor General Don Bailey wrote to him July 17, complaining that an ongoing investigation into allegations of cocaine use by former governn ent officials was "a mockery of decency.'

"It is my conclusion that independent counsel should be appointed in the matter involving Mr. Henry Barr," Specter said in his letter to deputy Attorney General William P. Barr. Henry Barr and William Barr are not related.

Biden, D-Delaware, chairman of the Senate Judiciary Committee, to hold a hearing into the confirmation of acting U.S. Attorney James West, whose office has been handling the cocaine use investigation, Specter spokesman Dan McK-

A federal grand jury investigation has focused on allegations that former Pennsylvania Deputy Attorney General Richard Guida used cocaine and gave it to friends. Specter also said Monday that a special prosecutor should decide whether or not to take control of the Guida case, as well.

According to documents filed in federal court, Guida gave the FBI information about supposed cocaine use by Henry Barr. The documents also indicated that investigators believe Guida falsely denied knowledge of any cocaine use by Henry Barr after September 1988, when he joined Thornburgh's staff. Henry Barr was a special assistant

Specter also asked U.S. Sen. Joseph coordinating criminal investigations until he resigned in May 1989.

Bailey has complained that the investigation will be tainted because West and Guida are friends who worked together for the state attorney general. Henry Barr also worked for Thornburgh when he was Pennsylvania governor. West recused himself from the investigation last year and it was turned over to his chief deputy, Gordon Zubrod.

McKenna noted that it would be "very unusual" for the Senate to hold a hearing on West's confirmation. U.S. attorney nominations are usually acted on without hearings, he said, but Specter feels the case warrants special atten-

"He feels it's necessary in light of Bailey's allegations," McKenna said. "He and others should have a chance to air their views on this.'

U.S. Justice Department spokesman Dan Eramian said officials there had not received Specter's letter Monday.

A press aide for Biden did not immediately return a telephone call to a reporter Monday. Bailey also was not in his office and could not be reached for comment. West declined to comment.

Zubrod received a judge's approval two weeks ago to dissolve a plea agreement the government had reached with Guida, clearing the way to proceed with drug-distribution and drug-use counts.

Despite the government's apparent progress on the case, Bailey told Specter the FBI "is more intent on assuring us of how limited Guida's activities were than on really investigating this thing in depth. This whole process is a mockery of decency.'

Bailey, who lost a re-election bid in 1988, has had a longstanding political feud with West over unrelated matters.

But since he nominated West, Specter has asked for the confirmation hearing "to make sure everything is as it should be," McKenna said.


