# Big Ten prepares for monumental task: Beating loward


With eight of the top 13 teams in the nation, the Big Ten is the premiere wrestling conference in the

On March 9 and 10, it will be decided which team rules the conference when the Big Ten Championships are held in East Lansing,

Last year, as in the past 22 years, the Iowa Hawkeyes took the Big Ten crown, and the consensus belief is that coach Dan Gable's squad will once again reign supreme.

"It should be pretty good competition for all of the other teams,' said Indiana coach Duane Goldman. "I think all of the other teams are looking for some good individual performances.'

Each of the 11 conference teams has a home in the Amateur Wrestling News Top 25. Now, a look at each of the competitors.

■ No. 1 Iowa Hawkeyes -- With three top-ranked and two secondranked wrestlers, the Hawkeyes are far and away the deepest, most talented team in the nation, none the less the Big Ten. Mike Mena (118), Jyeff McGinness (126), and

■ No. 4 Michigan State Spartans Michigan State (15-5) finished the Big Ten season at 8-3, and will have one last warm-up match against Oklahoma on March 2. The Spartans possess five top 10 wrestlers in David Morgan (118), Phil Judge (142), Joel Morissette (167), Erich Harvey (177) and Brian Picklo (190).

■ No. 8 Minnesota Golden Gophers — Minnesota broke a sixmeet losing streak with a 23-10 decision over Ohio State to finish 10-8-1 on the year, and 2-5 in the Big Ten. The Gophers are led by top-ranked Billy Pierce (Hwt), as well as No. 6 Jason Davids (142), No. 7 Gerald Carr (167) and No. 9 Chad Kraft (150).

"I think we can do pretty good," said coach J Robinson, whose team finished third at Big Tens last year. 'We're pretty young, but I think that everyone is in the same boat."

■ No. 18 Northwestern Wildcats The 8-5-1 Wildcats are led by No. 9 Scott Schatzman (126), No. 7 Tony Pariano (134), No. 6 Mark Bybee (158) and No. 4 Rohan Gardner (177). Northwestern has a few big conference wins over Minnesota. Wisconsin and Penn State.

■ No. 19 Ohio State Buckeyes -Buckeyes coach Russ Hellickson believes that his wrestlers have been underachievers at times, adding that the talent is there, but the effort has not been.

One consistent performer has been No. 4 Eric Smith (158), who finished fourth last year at Big Tens. Other top wrestlers include No. 6 Charlie Becks (150) and No. 13 Shawn Conyers (118).

■ No. 24 Purdue Boilermakers The Boilermakers finished at the bottom of the Big Ten with a 0-7-1 record. But their national ranking is a testament to the power of the conference. Purdue has three wrestlers in the top 10 at their respective weights — Tim Dernian 4118), Frank Laccone (134) and Tony Vaughn (Hwt).




