Dorsett went on to flash his No. 33 for 13 seasons in the NFL, mostly with the Dallas Cowbovs.

And he remains the only fourtime All-American in Pittsburgh football history.

His 6,256 career rushing yards and 380 points scored are still tops in the Panther record book.

The Panther triumph over Penn State in 1976 narrowed the all-time series between the two rivals to 37 wins for Penn State, 36 for Pittsburgh and three ties between the


