




Weather

University Park Forecast for Tuesday, Oct. 19

Cooler-than-normal temperatures will be the dominant feature this week. As high pressure moves off the East Coast tonight, a cold front over the Midwest will slide eastward, bringing us a chance of showers for midweek. Skies will clear during the day on Thursday into Friday, but a second cold front, accompanied by another chance of showers, should impact our weekend weather.

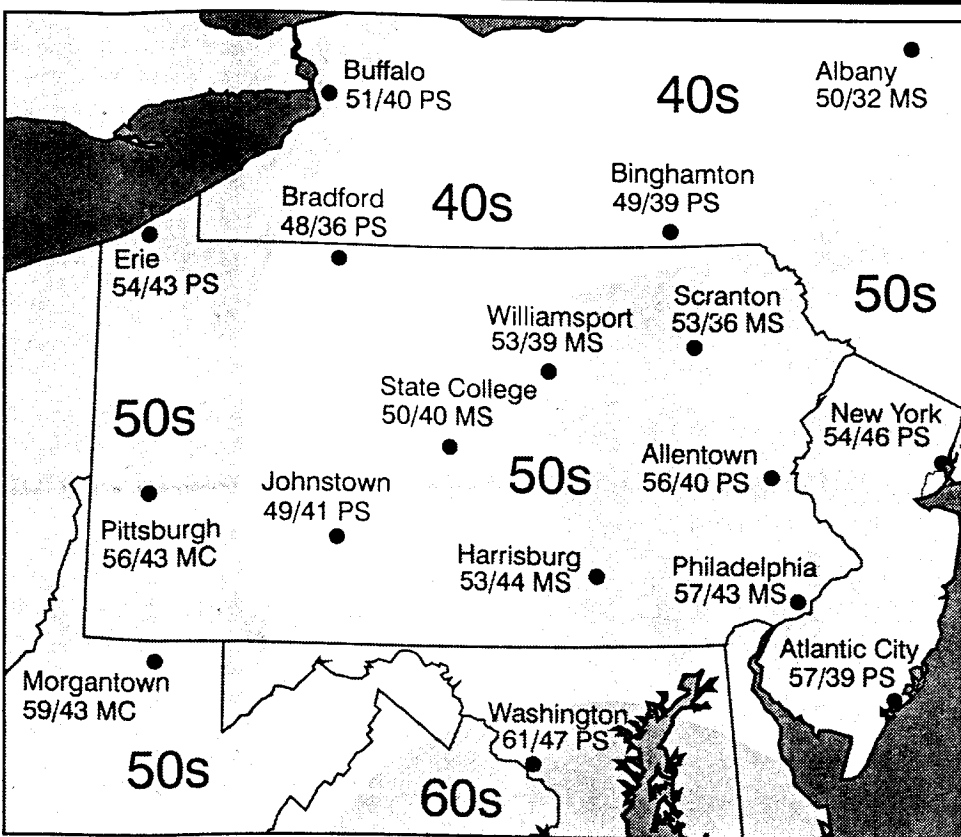

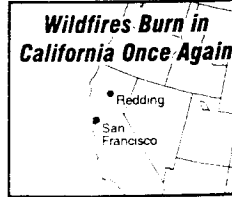
Regional Forecast Map



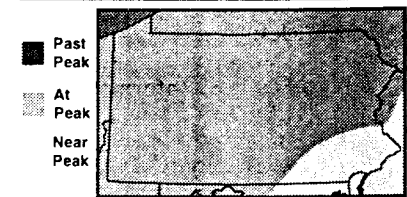
How to interpret this map Shades of gray indicate the expected high temperatures for today. Today's forecasted high and tomorrow morning's low are also shown for selected cities.
