Person (1-0) allowed four hits, struck out five, walked two and became the first Phillie pitcher to last through the sixth inning this season.

Ramirez's three homers lead Pirates to win

HOUSTON (AP) — Aramis Ramirez homered three times, leading the Pittsburgh Pirates over the Houston Astros 9-3 yesterday. Ramirez drove in a career-high six runs. He tied the team record for home runs in a game, becoming the first Pittsburgh player to do it since Darnell Coles against the Chicago Cubs on Sept. 20, 1987.
