The Nittany Lions (7-3) traveled to Virginia last week and came away with a victory.

The team stepped up defensively in the win and will need to showcase that intensity in front of its home crowd.

The Hokies (7-1) are coming off a 98-73 win over VMI, in which they blocked 17 of their opponents' shots. It tied a 16-year Hokies record.

The squad is averaging 15.8 offensive rebounds this season. If the Lions can reverse their trend of giving up offensive boards to their opponent, a win is possible.

Jeff Allen rebounded the ball 14 times in the last matchup between the two teams in 2007, which was a 66-61 victory for Penn State.

Without Jamelle Cornley in the middle this year, Jones and the rest of the front-court must crash the class early and often.

Greene also realizes the significance of her staying in the game.

With the team facing No. 15 Pittsburgh on Saturday and getting ready for Big Ten play, she thinks she will need to have more games like the one she had Wednesday for the Lady Lions to succeed.

"A lot," said the soft-spoken Greene about how much confidence she gained against Monmouth. "It shows I can rebound and score and contribute more to the team."

Going into the Monmouth game, Greene had averaged four fouls per game while fouling out twice.

This difficulty staying in games led to her contributing an average of only six points and less than five rebounds in the 17 minutes she averages per game.

But Wednesday's game showed why she was one of the most sought after recruits in the country.

"She's such an imposing presence," Washington said. "She has a presence for us offensively and defensively and the more she's on the floor the better team we are. I think she's going to continue as she gets more experience. She has played nine college games."

On top of her attacking ability, Murphy is also left-handed, which presents an unusual situation for the Lions. Rose said Murphy is unlike any setter they have seen this season, but his players have been studying film on the Gators and are trying to learn their tendencies.

"We kinda understand when she likes to [hit] so we can be prepared on our side of the net," junior Blair Brown said.

"We can either block it or defend it, we just have to know when it's coming."

Rose said Murphy is the type of player, like the Lions' Megan Hodge, that teams can talk about and try to prepare for, but until actually seeing her in the match, teams don't know how good she really is.

Another strong point for this

Gators team is that they too are battle-tested. Playing in what Rose called a very strong Southeastern Conference, the Gators are used to the type of competition the Lions bring with them.

Rose said he was particularly impressed with a win the Gators had over Kentucky back on Nov. 22.

With the Wildcats looking to lock up the SEC title, the Gators came into Memorial Coliseum in Lexington, Ky., and won in four sets.

The one thing the Lions do have over the Gators, though, is experience in the late rounds of the NCAA tournament.

"We do have some experiences in some areas that some other teams don't have," Rose said. "Whether it is the most important variable, I'm not sure, but I'm sure that it's a factor."
