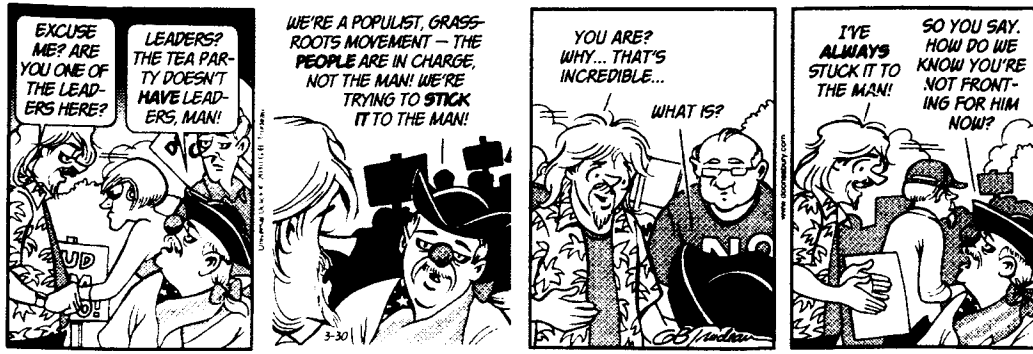

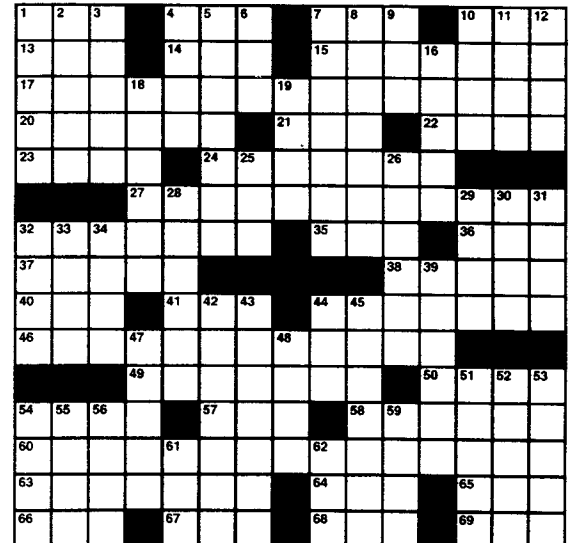

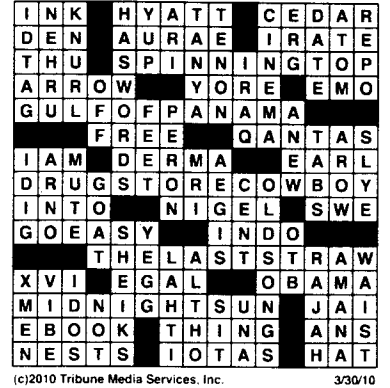

Contest sign-ups will take place from 12pm-1pm on Tuesday, March 30, 2010 and Wednesday, March 31, 2010. Sign-ups will take place in the HUB-Robeson Center.
