Group to perform Broadway show

In addition to the dance and musical performances featured throughout the Central Pennsylvania Festival of the Arts, visitors have the opportunity to get a taste of local theatrical performances at the State Theatre, 130 W. College Ave.

Singing Onstage, a State College musical theatre training and performance studio established in 2002, will perform "[title of show]" at 8:30 p.m. Thursday through Friday. An additional performance will show at 11 p.m. on Friday, specifically intended for Penn State students, Singing Onstage Director Richard Biever said.

The production will feature four Penn State Music Theatre students and a total of 10 props used to tell an edgy, non-traditional story, Biever said.

The seemingly pretentious title, "[title of show]," does justice to the show's central plot line. Hunter and Jeff, two men previously unknown to the Broadway scene, decide to write their own musical starring themselves and another two of their friends, Susan and Heidi. Following the plot line of any underdog

story, the duo's musical, simply titled "[title of show]," becomes highly successful and goes to Broadway.

"It's a show biz story about two things," Biever said. "It's about friendship getting you through tough times, and it's about following your dreams."

Biever said "[title of show]" is a relatively new production, as it was first performed on Broadway just last summer and is still largely unknown outside of the theatre world. Yet, its contemporary dialogue and timeless themes ensure that college-age students find it exciting and relevant, Biever said.

Mike Negra, executive director of the State Theatre, said Singing Onstage has performed several productions at the State Theatre in the past.

"They're a very popular local performing arts organization," Negra said. "The audience loves them."

will perform in the upper lobby studio stage, an intimate hall capable of seating just 50 spectators.

Presales have sold well, Negra said, and tickets to the show cost \$14.
