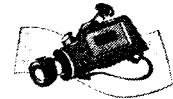

Take advantage of opportunities to interview with some of the country's top employers in our state-of-the-art interview center, located on the 2nd Floor of the Bank of America Career Services Center.

On-campus Interviewing (OCI) is a special feature of the Nittany Lion Career Network, especially for graduating seniors, offering the opportunity to interview for entry-level positions with a variety of employers; from business, industry, and government.

OCI is a pre-select system, where employers select candidates from among the students who request interviews with them. There is a one-time \$15.00 fee per academic year for the use of this service. Seniors can add OCI to your existing Nittany Lion Career Network account.
