

Three women's soccer players awarded for performances

In a game that lasted 109 minutes and 43 seconds, Taylor Schram only played 30 minutes and was one of two Penn State players to not record a single shot.

So forgive the freshman for being surprised to learn she won the Big Ten Freshman of the Week award after assisting junior midfielder Ali Schaefer's conference title-

"I had no idea," Schram said. "Yeah, I was very surprised, I didn't play a lot but I had that one play so I guess that did it."

Schram joined Schaefer and freshman defender Bri Hovington as the three Penn State women's soccer players to receive awards this week. Schaefer was named to TopDrawerSoccer.com's Team of the Week while Hovington won Big Ten co-Defensive Player of the Week recognition for her part in the team's 1-0 shutout victory.

Schram and Hovington said they didn't know they had won their awards until freshman forward Hayley Brock informed them - Hovington by text and Schram at dinner.

"It's an honor, it's exciting. I had been trying to do something like this all season," Schram said. "But

I couldn't have done it without my team right there behind me."

Schaefer had no idea she was named to the Team of the Week, but the junior was all smiles a day after her dramatic goal. She said she was definitely still riding the emotions of the end of Sunday's game.

"Every single moment since that game has been amazing, literally," Schaefer said. "Everyone just comes up and congratulates and hugs. I'm still sitting on cloud nine."

Over the past three weeks, a Penn State player has won at least

one of the conference's awards and a Nittany Lion has earned a Big Ten award in four of the past five weeks.

Schaefer and senior co-captain Megan Monroig said the three weeks of recognition prove the Lions are playing their best soccer heading into the NCAA Tournament.

"We all have each other's backs, we know what each other's strengths and weaknesses are and what we need to be doing for one another," Monroig said.
