Suisham hit all four of his fieldgoal attempts, including a 48yarder. His decisive kick capped a 13-play, 58-yard drive which Ben Roethlisberger kept alive by hitting Mike Wallace for a 17-yard catch to convert third-and-8.

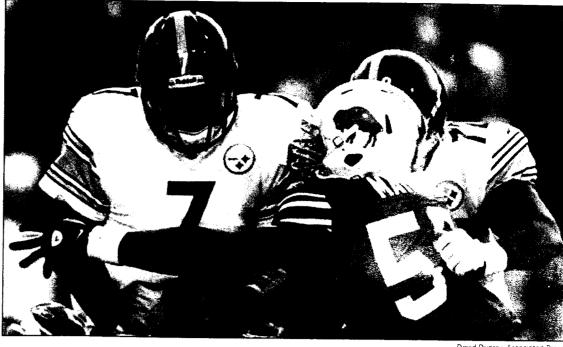
The Bills were also coming off a 49-31 win at Cincinnati, in which they overcame a 21-point first-half
