Clymer Men in Auto Wreck.

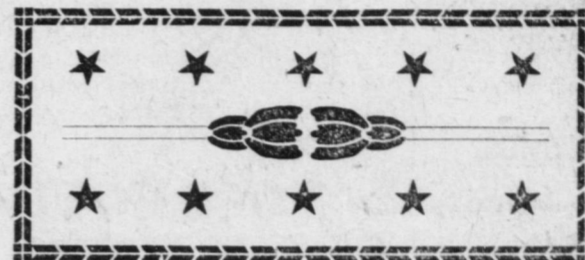
