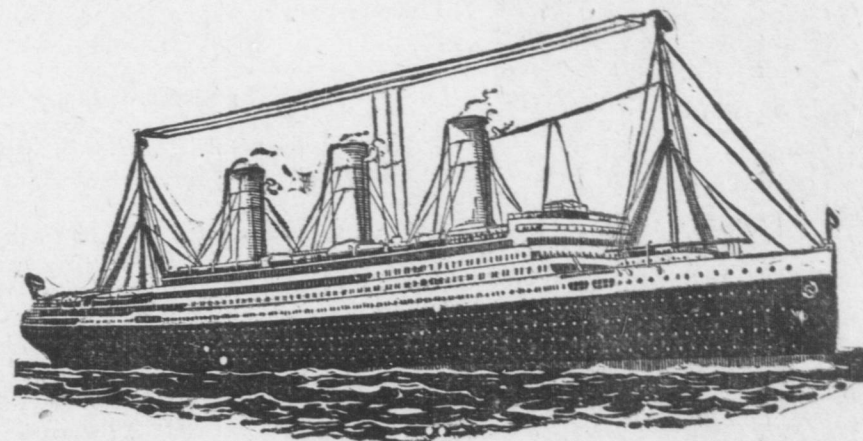
The time for payment of state and county tax for 1916 will expire on Sunday, October 15. After which date on all unpaid taxes .8 per cent. will be added.
