Who Fight our Battles. The Indianapolis State Standard is told by a gentleman, that an officer in one of the Indiana regiments, that an officer detailed by the War Department, under the direction of the Commander-in-chief, to muster into the service volunteers in Indiana, gives it as his opinion, based upon the most favorable opportunities of ascertaining the facts, that three-fourths of the men who have already volunteered for the war from that State are Democrats.
