

COMMUNION'S MESSAGE.

To the Honorable the Senate and House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania...

It has pleased Divine Providence, during the past session, to give us abundant crops of grain within our borders, unmitigated our people, and to her full duty to the country, to herself, and to posterity. For these blessings, we have cause to be grateful.

It is my duty to report to the Senate and House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, in relation to the operations of the State during the past year...

The States would submit from purchasing arms, as their competition was found injurious to the market, and in view of the large expenditures of money in arming and equipping the volunteer force of the State...

The last of December. On that day I expended \$6,400, and except some incidental payments made since, the balance remains in my hands. The report of the Auditor General will exhibit the items of the account.

Assurances have been received from the Treasury Department that the examination of the military accounts of the State will be proceeded in without delay, so that the State may receive a credit for the balance due in time to apply the same towards the payment of the quota of the direct tax...
