IMPORTANT LETTER!

Official Resolutions of the New York Tribune's... HARRISBURG, March 28, 1866.

About ten days after the adjournment of the late Democratic State Convention, the following statement appeared in the Washington correspondence of the New York Tribune:

"It will be remembered that the late Copthorn Convention of Pennsylvania, after nominating Mr. Clymer for Governor, passed a resolution endorsing the President."

"The false and unfounded assertions contained in the above extract have been reproduced, in various forms, in the Republican papers of the State. So long as the statements were of a general character it was deemed unnecessary to make a reply."

"Towards the end of the week in which the Convention assembled, I, in company with other Democratic Pennsylvania Senators and members, visited Washington, and while there, I met the Hon. H. B. Swaine."

"The candidate of our party was not, at any time or in any way, directly or indirectly, referred to by the President or ourselves. Nothing occurred during the interview which rendered it proper or necessary; nor did the President by any expression or suggestion, lead us to suppose that he was untruly to Mr. Clymer."

"I may here state upon the very highest authority, that the President himself emphatically repudiates and denies that he has ever, to any one, made any statement in reference to the nomination of Mr. Clymer, which could by possibility be attributed to him in the foregoing extract."

"The Republicans hope to be able to make much capital for General Geary out of the soldiers' vote. In this they will be mistaken. They have heretofore had the benefit of a much larger soldiers' vote than they can obtain in the coming contest."
