TROUBLE IN KANSAS.--A difficulty has occurred in Topeka. A bogus sheriff attempted to arrest a Free Soiler on a political charge, but was driven off by a number of citizens. He went away to some other town, procured a posse, and returned to take his prisoner. Again, however, the citizens interfered, and prevented the arrest. Thereupon the sheriff sent a message to acting governor Woodson, at LeCompton. The result had not transpired at the latest dates.

The bill to separate the office of Sup. of Common Schools from that of Secretary of the Commonwealth, has passed both Houses. We can not doubt so wise a measure will meet the Governor's prompt approval, and public opinion points unmistakably to the present Deputy, Henry C. Hickok, as the proper person to continue in the charge of the Department at the present important period in its history.

Rev. Mr. Kallied's trial in Boston having resulted in a disagreement of the jury his congregation has passed a resolution expressing undiminished confidence in him, and requesting him to resume his pastoral charge.
