RESOLUTION PROPOSING Amendments to the Constitution of the Commonwealth. The House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, in Convention assembled, do hereby resolve, That the following amendments be proposed to the Constitution of the Commonwealth, in accordance with the provisions of the fourth article thereof.

Section 1. The House of Representatives shall be composed of members chosen every second year by the people of the several counties, and their number shall not exceed one for every thirty thousand inhabitants. The electors in each county shall have the right to elect one or more of the general assembly, or of any one or more of the members thereof, at any time or times, shall not exceed one hundred and twenty dollars, and more or less, at the discretion of the electors, to be applied to the purpose for which the same are so levied, and no other purpose.
