

AGRICULTURAL.

A BORER UNDER WATER. Many of our young readers may have seen the work of the borer, or worm which bites its way into trees, a nibble at a time, leaving sawdust behind it. These insects are very destructive to apple and peach orchards; pine and other trees also suffer from their attacks.

It is believed by good authorities that the piles which gave strength to the embankment had been so weakened by the teredo, a small shell-fish. That has the best kind of an apparatus for boring wood, which it uses very effectually. A ship's bottom, unprotected by metal, would soon be pierced by millions of holes made by these minute workers.

As the severity of the weather moderates, the knife may be used in shaping—YOUNG TREES.—Cut them back to secure a stocky growth, and a well balanced form. Do not cut so close to a bud as to endanger it, nor so far above as to leave a stub.

Pruning.—There are many who are obliged to do it now; select a time when the wood is not frozen. Old trees and young ones may have a wash of soft soap, mixed with water enough to apply with a brush.—If there is much loose bark, or a great accumulation of moss, a blunt seraper may be used. Some are made for this use.
