"MURDER WILL OUT."—We learn that information has been received relative to the mysterious disappearance of Mr. RHEARNS, an aged and respected citizen of Schuylkill county. He has been missed for several months. A number of arrests have been made upon the suspicion of a person who alleges to have been acquainted with the man who put this unfortunate man in prison.

LEGISLATIVE.—We notice by the State proceedings that Hon. Geo. D. JACKSON, Senator from this District, has presented petitions from citizens of Catawissa, Berwick, Benton, Franklin, Greenwood, Hemlock, and Scott townships, this county, asking that the people of this Commonwealth may be allowed to vote on the question of "license" or no "license," for the sale of intoxicating drink as a beverage. We also notice that Mr. CHASE has presented several petitions of like import.

COLUMBIA COUNTY.—We are indebted to our Member for a copy of the Auditor General's report for the year ending November 30, 1895. The whole revenue of the State for the fiscal year was \$28,423,330.70. Of this amount Columbia County paid, on real and personal estate, \$1,126.62. The whole amount of tax paid into the State Treasury from this County, on licenses, Stocks, Corporations, &c., including that on real and personal estate, is \$13,907.35. This report makes some bad exhibitions, especially that of the Investigating Committee which was appointed by the Legislature of 1897.

FATAL ACCIDENT.—A son of Daniel Parsel met with an accident on Friday last, near Buckhorn, while on the road coming to this place with a four-horse load of ore. He attempted to get on the saddle horse while going, when the boy slipped and fell, the front wheel passing over his body. The team stopped at the boy's call, the wheel did not pass off the body, but remained on the young man's breast some fifteen minutes or more, until his cries brought several persons to the spot. It was with difficulty that four persons removed the weight, so heavily was the wagon loaded. He lingered under his extreme suffering until Monday morning last. He was about 20 years of age.

DISTRESSING ACCIDENT.—We learn from the Murrey Luminary, that a most distressing accident occurred near Elmport, in this county, on Friday last. Mr. Samuel Detrich, aged about 26 years, son of Joseph Detrich, was instantly killed by the breaking or "bursting" of a saw which he was sawing wood by horse power. A piece of the saw cut him through, commencing at the neck and passing down through the breast and back nearly or quite to the waist. Mr. Detrich is said to have been a hard working, industrious man, and much sympathy is felt for his sad fate.
