How to Make Good Coffee. Good coffee is a luxury, but one that is seldom met with. It is doubtful whether one family in a dozen know what really good coffee is.

The making of good coffee is a rare thing in this country; most persons boil it, thus making a decoction instead of an infusion; this effectually gets rid of the delicate and agreeable aromatic flavor, and leaves a comparatively tasteless beverage.

Never buy your coffee ground, but grind it yourself, immediately before using it. Keep your coffee pot, whatever kind you may use, wiped clean and dry inside; a damp tea or coffee pot acquires a nasty flavor that spoils the best tea or coffee.

The season is at hand when the fall season will be of importance to the farmer. Those who wish for thorough and labor provided at the proper season for such work, a sufficiency, are in the good condition to look white winter in the field; but if your field for the ensuing six months is not standing in the finest of your own maintenance, you will be suggestive of snow, work and spitting fires that go out on a road which is hard for you to travel.

Some dry wood can be gleamed by gathering the dead poles and trees before deepening snows fall, and there is one comfort in this work, which is that you are effecting a saving of more valuable timber and bringing your forest into a better state of culture.

After this you select the best kinds of wood for burning, such as poplar, birch, hickory, stands for most, then maple and beech, oak is perhaps the worst of all common wood for burning in an unseasoned state; yet when well seasoned under cover, is one of the very best, ranking next to hickory.
