PLANTING CORN IN DRILLS.—Of late years the subject of planting in drills instead of hills, has engaged considerable attention among some of our best farmers in various parts of the country, and as far as we can ascertain it is steadily winning its way into favor.

We have always thought, and frequently said in these columns, that there was not nearly as much importance attached to the fodder as its real value deserved.

CURE FOR THE EAR ACHES.—Take a small piece of cotton wool, make a depression in the centre with the end of the finger, and fill it with as much ground pepper as will rest on a silver five cent piece.

BEST FOOD FOR COWS.—A correspondent of the Boston Cultivator says: I have found that good clover hay, cut green from rich ground and well cured, is the best hay to make cows give milk; and that the best pasture is high land, newly cleared and seeded to clover or timothy.
