The election returns are rather meager, both in county and State. They come in slow, and in many instances very incorrect. The State, last fall, was claimed by the Radicals, for a week after the election, but on the final and official count they had to give it over to the Democracy by 922 majority.

The Fair on Wednesday and Thursday was rather slenderly attended. The unfavorable weather no doubt prevented many from coming to the exhibition. The articles entered are fine and will compare favorably with any on exhibition at our previous fairs. The usual number of strangers, gamblers, and pickpockets, are on hand. So far we have not heard of their having "gone through" any one.

Later.—The Fair at this writing presents quite a different aspect as regards articles on exhibition and people in attendance—Additional articles were brought up on the ground, and people have been coming in from all quarters, upon every train, until the number present at the Fair will exceed that to other fairs on the several days.
