NAMES OF ANIMALS.

The Meaning of Some of Those Who Origina We Can Trace.

Some of the names of the commonest animals are lost in the dimness of antiquity, such as fox, weasel, sheep, horse, dog and baboon.

Lynx is from the same Latin root as the word lux (light) and probably was given to the cat on account of the fierce brightness of their eyes.

Puma, jaguar, tapir and pecary (from pecunia) are all names from South American Indian languages.

Moose is from the Indian word moosh, meaning wood.

Rhinoceros is pure Greek, meaning nose horned, but leaves an odd had a rough time of it in its travels through various languages.

Elk is derived from the Latin word elvus, meaning wild.

Deer is of obscure origin, but may have been an adjective, meaning wild.

Antelope is an interesting word. It meant sufferer, and was applied by the Teutons to the elk of the old world on account of the awkward gait and stiff movements of this ungainly animal.

Squirrel has a poetic origin in the Greek language, its original meaning being shadow tall. Tiger is far more intricate.
