HOW TO CLEAN SEED WHEAT.

There are sometimes seeds of charlock, winterweed, cockle, chess, dock, pigeon weed, oats, and some other kind among seed wheat.

If a person has nothing but a common fanning mill for cleaning seed wheat, the sieves can usually be arranged to separate every thing from the best grain.

After such seeds have been separated, should there be oats among the seed wheat, a sieve made of perforated tin, or zinc, should be placed in the lower gage of the shoe, and the wheat put through the mill again.

Ordinary barn-yard manure is to be used for corn fertilizing, it ought to be all added and spread over the surface by the last week in March.

Most people attach no importance to the directions of the rows in a corn-field, but if they will only see common sense to work, it will tell them pretty plainly the corn in all the first stages of growth, until the ears have begun to glaze, requires the light sun warmth of the sun as early in the morning and as late in the evening, as it can possibly get it.

Every thing else being equal, the acre of corn thus planted in the same field, with another acre planted the reverse, will be believed yield five bushels the most grain, and an equal excess of fodder.
