It contains the State coal shell penetrating her casemate forward, wounding three men, soother lodging in the wheel. The Duncsa returned their fire briskly, killing two and wounding several. The following night the same hand of rebels fired into what they supposed to be two transparts, but which proved to be the dag ship Lexington and marine bost Diana After a cannonade of about thirty minute's duration, the Lexington had it all her own way, as she always does ; a squad of cavalry, 100 strong, were sent in pursuit, and chased them three miles. The killed on the rebel side were one major and eight privates, besides thirty wounded ; the Diana had one man wounded. About a month ago this boat, in company with three others, was fired into by about five hundred guerillas A tew shell were dropped in their midst to enliven the occasion, killing 24 and wounding about 40, which seems to have made them consider that discretion was the better part of valor.
