The Ways and Means Commission to-day decided definitely in regard to the tax upon petroleum. Upon the article they impose a tax of six cents per gallon. They leave the tax upon the manufactured article as it now is, which is twenty cents per gallon.—Washington Correspondent.

It strikes us that the so-called "wise men" at Washington are disposed to "go it a little strong" on the petroleum question. The tax on that article is now larger than on any other one of common use, and the proposed increase will swell it beyond all just proportions. Petroleum has become as much an article of necessity in nearly every household as the land as wheat and potatoes, and we are at a loss to comprehend the theory which leaves the latter entirely exempt from tax, and burdens the former to an extent as oppressive, unjust and ruinous. We are informed that the proposed increase of tax will amount to about 30 cents on the refined oil, and that its effect will be to destroy the small refiners, place the business in the control of the heavy capital, and of course enable them to put up the cost to consumers at an exorbitant standard.

**COUNTY FINANCES.**—The County Commissioners publish in the Republican their Annual Statement of the receipts and expenditures of Erie County. This document is one of importance to every tax-payer, without reference to his politics, and in almost every other county in the State it is furnished to the papers; but the Commissioners of Erie county being of the excessively "loyal" stripe, cannot be expected to manifest the same degree of liberality and regard for the interests of the people. **IMPORTANT DECISION.**—An important decision was recently delivered by Judge Loomis, in the Court of Common Pleas, on the subject of the military bounty laws. The facts involved in the case are as follows: Two citizens of Manheim township, Lancaster county, having furnished acceptable substitutes for themselves in the military service, made issue to the effect that having thus contributed what they deemed their quota, they should be rightfully and legally exempted from the payment of the tax provided for by the act of 20th of March, 1864, to pay bounties to volunteers. The suit was brought by the Board of School Directors of Manheim township, who in compliance with the provisions of the law, were authorized to levy and collect such a tax. After a thorough discussion of the question involved, by able counsel, the court held that the defendants were not entitled for payment of tax, and accordingly ordered judgment to be entered for the plaintiffs.—Lancaster Examiner.
