The Draft to Take Place on the 6th of March.
A letter from the editor of the Observer from Col. Campbell, dated Ridgway, Monday, the 20th inst., contains the following:
"I received a telegram to day from the War Department, ordering the draft to take place on Monday, the 27th inst. The preparations for this draft are not complete, as the prompt execution of this order cannot be complied with.
The draft in this district will take place, if not otherwise ordered, on Monday, the 6th of March.

"In this connection we must take occasion to thank Col. Campbell for the courtesy displayed towards us ever since he has had charge of the Provost Marshal's office. He has never discriminated between this office and the others in furnishing important information to the public, has promptly and kindly answered all letters of inquiry addressed to him on matters of interest to our readers, and in every respect has borne himself towards us like a manly and fair minded public official. In these days, when party spirit runs with such vindictive bitterness, we deem such instances worthy of record.

Oil Operations near Jackson's Station.—We learn that very extensive operations in real estate for oil operations, have been going on in Summit township, especially in the neighborhood of Jackson's Station. A large and wealthy company in this city, including among others, such well known and successful oil men as Messrs. Hammond, Noble, Sherman, and Lamb, have leased all the land in that locality that could be secured, and we are told, feel quite confident that it will be found a productive section. They are putting down a test well about three-fourths of a mile from Jackson's station, and have put in charge of a man who has had extensive experience in that line on Oil Creek. The site of this well, we are informed, was selected by Mr. John Ferdynt, who has been extremely fortunate in picking out good oil sites in the neighborhood of Titusville. The well was commenced in 1861 by other parties, but abandoned on account of the depression in the oil trade at the beginning of the war. We have been somewhat of a disbeliever in the idea of obtaining oil in paying quantities in this county, but the fact that gentlemen who have made enormous fortunes on Oil Creek are leasing so largely in the section named, and spending their money in such a manner, surely looks as if they had faith in experts here. As a consequence of their movements, land in Summit has taken a rapid rise, and farms there which would have sold for \$50 and \$60 per acre a few months ago, the owners now ask from \$100 to \$150 per acre. For Summit is a gallant little Democratic township, and if oil should be found there sufficient to make all our friends rich, we shall feel unusually gratified.
We have good reason to believe that a large proportion of the stories we hear about large fortunes being made in the oil regions are exaggerated. A few men certainly do have extraordinary success, but the mass of the dabblers in oil speculations are doing no better than people in other places. It is true that wages and prices are higher there than elsewhere, but it must be remembered that expenses are proportionately large. When one hears of an acquaintance having made a considerable money in oil or property a safe method is to divide the reported amount by ten, by which means an approximation to the real sum will probably be reached.
