Johnston's Surrender.

A correspondent of the New York Daily News gives the following particulars of the surrender of Johnston's army to Sherman:

Gen Grant arrived at Sherman's headquarters at 7 o'clock on the morning of the 24th, and immediately informed him of the decision of the Government on the "memorandum of agreement" with Johnston.

Gen Grant merely communicated the desire of the President that no proposition regarding the political or civil status of the States should be entertained by Sherman or any other military commander, and that hostilities should be resumed as soon as practicable.

On the following morning, a note was received from Johnston, requesting an interview for the purpose of reconsidering the terms embraced in the first agreement.

He proposed to surrender his army, but intimated a desire to confer with Sherman on some subjects that were not strictly within the scope of Sherman's authority.

The handsome furnished mansion on West Chestnut street, purchased and fitted up at a cost of fifty thousand dollars by the citizens of Philadelphia as a present to our Lieutenant General, was opened on Saturday for inspection, and in the course of the day was visited by a large number of ladies and gentlemen.

The mansion is twenty-two feet front, one hundred and five feet deep, and stands on both sides, and nothing was to be done but to reduce them to writing.
