In 1814 delegates from all the States met at Hartford to plan a movement to take New England out of the Union. Upon the statute book of every State are laws to nullify the provisions, not merely of the uts of Congress, but of the Constitution. Up to this day—in its application to herelf—New England resists the doctrine of the right of the majority to rule, and is us greedy for laws conferring peculiar advantages upon herself as she is inimical to such as may operate to the profit of any other section of the country. Equally intolerant and insubordinate, selfish and conceited, her ideas and her own interests—in the advocacy of both of which she has been equally fierce and fanaticalthave on several previous occasions nearly plunged the country into the horrors of ceivil contention. And now that she bed succeeded—now that the land is tortured in every nerve and bleeding at every pore, New England, safe from invicion, happy in the mischief she has begotten, and pleased to the very soul at he tright of the baptism of blood which she invoked and inaugurated, enjoys the favors of the Government, and grows rich out of the miseries of the people.—Ex.


