A New Jersey newspaper states, "In every county in South Jersey, and in the hog cholera is so raging, and its spread is so rapid and the rate of mortality so large that farmers are greatly exercised about it. It is thought that it first appeared at Pemberton, where it is still epidemic and from whence it has extended. In Atlantic county and along the coast it is especially severe. The superintendent of Genitor Gaskill's farm, near Pemberton, says it is his opinion that the disease is not the true hog cholera, but something more of the nature of pleuro-pneumonia in cattle. The hogs' lungs are affected. Many porkers are dying in the vicinity of Paulsboro, Gloucester county. The cholera has also obtained a firm foothold in Warren and Mercer counties, and will most likely run through the entire State.
