LEGAL ELECTION PROCLAMATION.

WHEREAS, by an act of General Assembly, entitled "An act relating to elections in this Commonwealth," passed the 18th day of March, 1897, and its supplements, it is the duty of the Sheriff of every county within this Commonwealth to give public notice and to enumerate the Officers to be Elected.

Tuesday, November 5, 1899.

(It being the first Tuesday after the first Monday of said month,) a General Election will be held in the several election districts established by law in said county, at which time they will vote by ballot for the several officers to be elected.
