CONSTITUTIONAL CONVENTION. OFFICE OF THE SECRETARY OF THE COMMONWEALTH, HARRISBURG, Pa., September 25th, 1891.

In compliance with the provisions of the Act of the General Assembly, entitled 'An Act to amend the Constitution, and the election of delegates thereto,' approved the 19th day of June, 1891, the following list of qualified electors of this Commonwealth shall vote for or against holding a convention to amend the Constitution...

SECTION 2. It is the duty of the electors of this Commonwealth to give their votes in favor of a convention to amend the Constitution, the said convention shall be composed of the qualified electors of this Commonwealth, delegates to be chosen from each Senatorial district, and the three candidates highest in vote shall be declared elected...
