Quay For President In 1896.

Within the period of a Senatorial term at Washington, Senator Quay has come forward as the foremost, practical champion of popular election in the United States.

It is not to be expected that the people of this State should be instructed to the powers that should be entrusted to the people, and among the limited, is the one that it is not safe to entrust the election of a United States Senator to the people.

The people do not believe that Quay, like Abraham Lincoln trusts the people, and he has the courage of his convictions, to practice what he preaches, and present himself as a candidate for the nomination of United States Senator.

The people of his party have rallied to his support, and if it were possible for Mr. Quay at this time to get away from the Legislature forms that surround the election of an United States Senator, and become a candidate for United States Senate before the whole people, regardless of party, he would be elected by a majority that would settle the doubts as to how the people feel on the question of electing Senators.

Quay's espousal of the rights of the people to elect the highest officers in the nation by a popular vote, clearly proves him to be the champion of all the political rights of the people in the selection of their officers, and puts him in the minds of the people as a candidate for the Presidency in 1896.

For United States Senate M. S. Quay ranks as one of the far seeing statesmen of the age, and the first man for the office of United States Senator who is so thoroughly in accord with the popular vote system of electing officers that we promptly seconded the desire of the people of the Republican party to submit the question of election of United States Senator to a vote.

That act has placed him head and shoulders above other senatorial politicians in this or any other state for up to this time senatorial candidates have opposed submitting their aspirations to a vote of the people. Mr. Quay is not an old man and it is within the line of a possibility that before his next term expires in the Senate, he may become a candidate for the Presidency and submit his nomination to a popular vote.
