Harrison and the Supreme Bench.

PRESENT HARRISON'S appointment of Judge Jackson of Tennessee, to the Supreme Bench, does not give satisfaction. Because Judge Jackson is the representative of a class of lawyers and jurists, that believe the State is independent of the nation when a majority of the citizens of a State declare themselves in favor of a line of policy or government that is not approved by the national government. For example: The late Confederate government was organized under the doctrine of State rights. They claim that they had the right to secede from the general government, because a majority of the people of the seceding states had expressed a desire by ballot at the polls to withdraw, and under that claim they set up the Confederate government. Judge Jackson, however, in that doctrine of State rights, if he is correctly reported, said for that reason should not hold a position as Judge on the Bench of Supreme Court of the United States. Part of a majority of men on the Supreme Bench, who believe as does Judge Jackson on the question of State rights, and within the next 20 years the Supreme Court will have decided that the war against rebellion was unconstitutional, null and void. Then the negro goes back to slavery, and the Lord only can know what will follow. The Republicans are not pleased with the appointment, because of the danger pointed out above. The Democrats are pleased and displeased. Pleased, because, Jackson is a democrat; displeased, because, if Jackson's appointment is confirmed by the Senate, they believe Harrison will fill the office of Circuit Judge, that Jackson vacates in the south with a Republican Judge. There is no assurance however, if the Senate does confirm the appointment of Jackson, that Harrison will appoint a Republican Judge in the South. What Harrison may do is hard to forecast. He fought against the rule of States rights man in the office, where he can do the most effective work, against the central policy of the United States Government as represented by the people, who elected Harrison to the Presidency.

A Fiend Burned.
